Dual Eligible Special Needs Plan Model of Care Training for Medicare Advantage HMO Provider **Groups Due September 30, 2023**

Health care providers and staff who deliver care to Dual Eligible Special Needs Plan (D-SNP) members and are contracted by managed care organizations, such as Florida Blue Medicare, are required by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services to receive basic training on the D-SNP Model of Care. To ensure compliance, your provider group must complete this course and submit the required attestation by September 30, 2023. Learn more>>

Pharmacy Updates to Commercially Insured Medical Coverage Guidelines Now Available

Each month and quarter, our Medical Coverage Guidelines (MCGs) for the Commercially insured are updated and published at FloridaBlue.com under Medical and Pharmacy Policies and Guidelines, What's New. The September 15, 2023 updates include, but are not limited to, the new Vyjuvek MCG for the treatment of wounds in members with Dystrophic Epidermolysis Bullosa with a mutation in the collagen type VII alpha 1 chain (COL7A1) gene. This update also shows two new MCGs, **Epkinly and Columvi**, for use with patients who have diffuse large B-cell lymphoma and other types of lymphomas. Self-Service Portal Update: Access Will Pause Until Provider Profile is Validated

Federal legislation initiated last year, requires all providers, health care facilities, and suppliers to regularly verify (or update) profile information for provider directories – even if nothing has changed. Starting **September 28, 2023**, you will only be able to advance in our provider self-service portal in Availity *after* you have validated your profile information by the quarterly deadline. *Learn more>>*
