Updates to Commercially Insured Pharmacy Medical Coverage Guidelines Now Available

Each month and quarter, our Medical Coverage Guidelines (MCGs) for the Commercially insured are updated and published at FloridaBlue.com under Medical and Pharmacy Policies and Guidelines, What's New. This month, as of March 15, updates include, but are not limited to the new Furoscix MCG. This is used for the outpatient treatment of congestion due to fluid overload in patients with chronic heart failure. This update also shows the Enjaymo MCG which removes a requirement for

blood transfusion. On April 1, **Mounjaro**, which is subject to step therapy, will be added to coverage for our Commercial and Truli formularies where brand drugs are covered. Many other MCG updates are listed. **Learn more>>**
