More financial assistance is available for Marketplace health insurance plans. If you haven't looked lately, here are some numbers you may find interesting.

Get Covered Florida

3.2 million

is the number of people in Florida who enrolled in Marketplace health insurance in 2023.¹

\$10

or less per month is what more than 1 in 3 people in Florida paid for their Marketplace plans in 2023.²

460,000

uninsured people in Florida could get health coverage with a \$0 monthly payment³ after financial assistance.⁴

9 out of 10

people in Florida with Marketplace plans got help paying their premiums in 2023.²

Could this be you?



Parents in their 50s with 2 teenagers can earn \$139,000 and only have a monthly payment of \$10 after financial help.⁵



A single 28-year-old could earn \$41,000 and pay \$10 a month for their health plan after financial help.⁵
