HEALTH CARE PLANS (MEDICARE ADVANTAGE)

D-SNP Basic Training Required for Medicare Advantage HMO Provider Groups by Sept. 30, 2021

Health care providers and staff who deliver care to Dual-Eligible Special Needs Plan (D-SNP) members are required by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) to complete basic training every year on the D-SNP Model of Care. This annual requirement applies to all health care providers contracted by managed care organizations, such as Florida Blue Medicare. To ensure compliance, provider groups must complete this course and submit the required attestation by **Sept. 30**, **2021.** Learn more>>
