Changes in Pharmacy Coverage Affect Select Drugs as of July 1, 2021

Starting July 1, 2021, Neulasta, Neulasta OnPro and Ziextenzo will be required before allowing coverage of other pegfilgrastim biosimilar products. Udenyca will no longer be a preferred option. Patients with existing authorizations for Udenyca can continue for the duration of their current authorization. This change only applies to our commercial members being newly initiated on treatment. <u>Learn more>></u>
