# D-SNP Model of Care: Medicare Advantage HMO Provider Groups' Training Deadline is October 31, 2023

Health care providers and staff who deliver care to Dual Eligible Special Needs Plan (D-SNP) members and are contracted by managed care organizations, such as Florida Blue Medicare, are required by CMS to receive basic training on the D-SNP Model of Care. To ensure compliance, your provider group must complete this course and submit the required attestation **by October 31, 2023**. **Learn more>>**
