## Federal Employee Program Encouraging Breast Cancer Screening for Members

Florida Blue patients (women between the ages of 50 to 74) insured under the Blue Cross and Blue Shield Federal Employee Program<sup>®</sup> (FEP) will receive a letter this month encouraging them to screen for breast cancer. In the letter, our medical director recommends your FEP patients contact a Primary Care Physician, OB/GYN, or preferred (in-network) mammogram imaging center to schedule **mammograms.** The member cost share is \$0 for these diagnostic tests when they visit an in-network provider.

One in every eight women will get breast cancer in her lifetime. Routine mammograms can find breast changes early before symptoms even develop. When detected early, cancer treatment is typically most effective.

## How You Can Help

- Discuss the importance of breast cancer screening and ensure your patients are up to date with an annual mammogram.
- Document the screening for breast cancer in the medical record; ensure the **specific date** and **result** of the screening are indicated.
- Document medical and surgical history of the breast, including dates, in the medical record.
- MRIs, ultrasounds, or biopsies do not apply to this measure. Although these
  procedures may be indicated for evaluating women at higher risk for breast cancer or for
  diagnostic purposes, they are performed as an adjunct to mammography and do not
  alone count towards the Healthcare Effectiveness Data and Information Set (HEDIS<sup>®1</sup>)
  care gap compliance.
- Submit the appropriate diagnosis and procedure codes for the services rendered.
